**MINUTES** of the **Environment and Planning Committee** held on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2017 at 7.00 pm in the Corn Exchange Complex, Hungerford.

**Present:** Cllrs Winsor, Brookman, Chicken & Simpson.

1. **Apologies for absence.** Cllrs Farrell, Knight, Crane, Small & Hudson. Also Whiting & Finlay.
2. **Declarations of interest.** None
3. **Minutes of the meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2017.** Cllr Simpson proposed the minutes as a true record, seconded by Cllr Brookman, all in favour.
4. **Planning Applications: -**

Proposed roof space conversion, single storey extension and drop kerb.

Proposed single storey rear extension and alterations  
  
Cllr Chicken proposed **No Objections**, seconded by Cllr Brookman, all in favour.
  - (c) **17/01755/LBC2**  
**Town Hall, High Street**  
**Vodafone Ltd and CTIL**  
12no Remote Radio units (RRU) mounted on wall brackets, to be relocated from internal clock room to belfry.  
  
Cllr Winsor proposed **No Objections**, seconded by Cllr Chicken, all in favour.
6. **Case Officers Reports: - These were read out and noted**
7. **Feed-back on meeting with Cold Ash Parish Council about the Judicial Review.** Cllrs Knight, Hudson and Simpson meet with the Chair of the Parish Council and councillor from Cold Ash. They had

experienced an increase in the size of all planned sites in their parish. HTC were asked if similar had happened in their planned site. Cold Ash Parish council did not have a budget for judicial review and were unable to take similar action. Cllr Brookman asked if we need to return to WBC to ask why the area in the planning application had changed. Cllr Simpson thought that Cllr Hudson was investigating this.
