Minutes of the **Tourism and Economy Committee** held on Monday 11th June 2018 at 8.00 pm in The Library, Hungerford

Present: Cllrs Crane, Chicken and Simpson.

Also present Nigel Perrin (NP) and Fiona Hobson (FH) from Town Team.

- 1. Election of a Chair for the Committee** – Cllr Simpson proposed Cllr Crane as Chair, seconded by Cllr Chicken, all in favour.
- 2. Election of a Deputy-chair for the Committee** – Cllr Simpson proposed Cllr Chicken as Deputy Chair, seconded by Cllr Crane, all in favour.
- 3. Apologies for absence** – Apologies were noted from Cllr Downe and Cllr Knight
- 4. Declarations of interests** - None
- 5. Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 11th April 2018** – Cllr Crane proposed minutes of 11th April 2018 as a true record, seconded by Cllr Chicken, one abstention, rest in favour.
- 6. Welcome Signage – Update from Cllr Crane on progress with North Wessex Downs on the sign and consideration of a different approach to placing welcome signage at the entrance of the town**
Cllr Crane advised AONB has yet to make a decision. He suggested a banner be produced and hung on the steel poles by Charnham Park to gauge public opinion.
Action – NP to obtain quote to produce banner based on the station sign design, and circulate.
- 7. Town Leaflet – Update from Nigel Perrin on the amended “the town and its attractions” leaflet** – I3 Web has offered to add links to the leaflet but would charge for this. NP could highlight where links could go and both I3web and Penny Post could look at this if required. There is a QR code that already works and a short URL could be created if needed. Most of the content of the leaflet is fine but the photos will be changed. The Library/Community Hub needs to be added to the map. Quotations obtained for new artwork, printing and delivery are as follows: - £594 (5000 copies), £697 (£7500 copies) and £810 (10,000 copies). The leaflets could be delivered within a 50 mile radius. A separate issue on notification on sat navs of points of interest was discussed but decided not to pursue.
Action – FH to investigate cost of delivery of leaflets within a 50 miles radius to targeted locations
Action – Cllr Crane proposed NP proceeds with the updates to the leaflet and arranges the printing of 5000 copies at a price of £594, but not to include links, seconded by Cllr Chicken, all in favour.
- 8. Hungerford Trade Showcase - Update on response to “Save the Date” flier sent out by office** –
Action - Office to consider sending out a booking form or a chaser for responses
Update on businesses visited by Cllr Crane and Cllr Downe – A successful visit took place to Berkshire Labels.

9. **Update on the Great West Way following the meeting on 27th April and Clarification of costs payable by HTC for inclusion in Great West Way** - See attached info below on cost. A meeting will take place with Town & Manor to see what level of involvement they would support.
