In response to our request not to implement the changes to the parking meters for the car parks, WBC advised: *For the off-street car parks, this has already been agreed and the necessary legal orders amended. The tariff changes will be implemented from w/c 18 November.*

WBC further advised: *It is worth noting that we are all awaiting the details of the Council's budget consultation which is launching on 11th Nov. I am not expecting parking charges to be listed individually but I expect there will be a general statement above all fees and charges increasing for 2025/26. It would be worth looking out for this and responding accordingly.*
