EP2021025 WBC Settlement Boundary Review – Discuss proposed new settlement boundaries and consider response to be submitted by 21st April 2021.

Maps showing the proposed new settlement boundaries in Hungerford and Eddington had been circulated. The committee previously looked at this in March 2020 and suggested the settlement boundary be amended to reflect the current approved planning development at Salisbury Road; this is now reflected on the new map.

ACTION: Office to respond to WBC stating HTC accepts the proposed new settlement boundaries. However, WBC will be asked to supply more details to enable HTC to understand the rationale behind the changes to the boundary along the A4 in the area between Cottrell Close and the Veterinary Hospital.

EP2021026 Mobile pizza trailer – Dapao Takeaway – Discuss possible locations for siting of trailer.

In order for a trading licence to be granted, the traders need a designated site to trade from and they are currently in the process of investigating possible locations.
